SFB SAFETY & CLEANING INITIATIVE (SCI)

As we are sure you are aware, the SFB is knee deep in recruiting the Blocks and businesses in Phase 2 (Between Beach and Main Road, from Glengarrif to Saunders Rocks) to take part in our Safety & Cleaning Initiative after we enjoyed success in Phase 1 (Beach Road) . This will allow us to have more security patrolling the area and have a cleaner and a safer Atlantic Seaboard.

STRAATWERK

We work hand in hand with the incredible NPO Straatwerk. They clean the Beach Road 7 days per week and the tributary roads 3 days (Tuesday, Thursday and Saturdays) per week. Our goal is to have 3 shifts per day, 7 days a week. Straatwerk also manages our Upliftment Programme where the homeless are recruited in order to give them the dignity of a daily income. Straatwerk depot also have sanitation and laundry facilities, but even more importantly, they offer life skills workshop and job readiness programmes. They also have successful savings plans where they help the homeless obtain their ID's and save up to travel back home to their loved ones. Over the last few months we have recruited 57 homeless onto our programme.

Our Fieldworker, Jantjie Booysen, works closely with Straatwerk and the Social Services Department in assisting the homeless with their various needs.

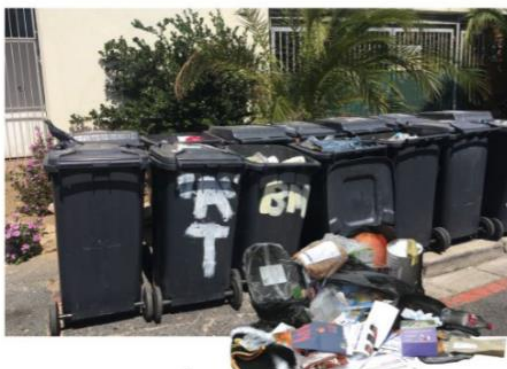
