WHAT IS A RATEPAYERS ASSOCIATION?

A Ratepayers association is a civic organisation recognised by the City of Cape Town and is registered with the sub-council but does not have a legal jurisdiction in terms of the City. There is no specific framework or by-law around ratepayers organisations. However, once civic organisations are registered on the database, they are circulated with copies of all draft by-laws, policies, liquor licence applications, etc. for comment. Should the Ratepayers Association indicate an interest in planning matters, planning applications will also be circulated to them for input. In summary, once registered, organisations are consulted in terms of public participation processes.

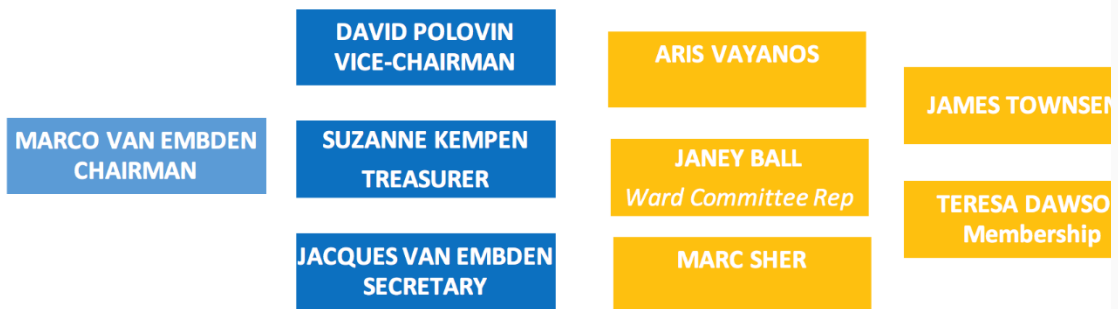


SFB AGM
