Reports from our partners in Security, Cleansing & Fieldworker show the ground we have covered in PHASE 1 (Beach Rd from 3 Anchor Bay to Saunders Rocks).

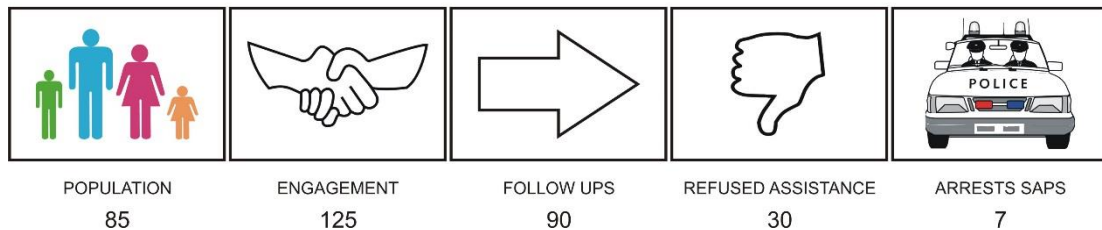

DISPLACED PERSONS DATA

Focussing on criminally orientated hotspots on Sea Point Promenade Beach Road and side roads



CLEANSING:

800 bags of rubbish collected (over and above the City's weekly collection)

14,500 doggy poo bags dispensed into Dispensers provided along the promenade.

The net result is that the spaces in Sea Point are safer and cleaner than they were and residents and visitors alike have been enjoying the fruits of the initiative for some time now.

HIGHER WATER TARIFFS FOR HEAVY WATER USERS!

Some Water saving tips :

- * Advise Cleaners, Caretakers, Caregivers, Guests, Visitors to use water sparingly.
- * In the shower turn off the water once you are wet, then soap and wash yourself and turn on the water to rinse soap off. Try not to leave the water running all the time.
- * Put a bucket in the shower to collect excess water for your plants.
- * While brushing your teeth turn off the tap, only turn it on to rinse.
- * If possible, redirect grey water to your thirsty garden.
- * If it's yellow let it mellow, if it's brown flush it down!
