



Estate agencies keeping neighbourhoods safer and cleaner

Ratepayers associations are civic organisations addressing issues within their boundaries of representation for the residents of a particular area through one, unified voice. The role of the SFB (Sea Point, Fresnaye and Bantry Bay) Ratepayers Association is no different. Their Safety & Cleaning initiative serves to take care of the community, instilling a sense of pride backed by action.

Now the SFB Ratepayers Association in partnership with corporate sponsors Pam Golding Properties and Dogon Group Properties, and support sponsors Century 21, Durr Estates, Jawitz, Knight Frank, RE/MAX Living, Seeff, Sotheby's, Tyson Properties and REBOSA, are taking further steps to ensure that the areas are safer and cleaner for both residents and visitors alike.

This is what the SFB Safety & Cleaning initiative take on in the Sea Point area:

- Tackle crime, litter and general lawlessness.
- Have security officers patrolling Beach Road and the Promenade (Phase I) and some side roads (Phase II) 24/7 on four dedicated Segways.
- Clean up the beachfront with the NPO Straatwerk seven days a week (Phase I), and three days a week (Phase II – the link roads connecting Beach and Main Roads).
- Employ a fieldworker to engage with and assist the homeless.
- Remove rubbish in the area.
- Supply dog poo bags in dispensers.

These are the additional services they plan to add with your support:

1. One more Segway to supplement those patrolling in Phase I.
2. Increase the cleaning by Straatwerk from three to seven days a week in Phase II.
3. Increase fieldworker from part-time to full-time.
4. Install further Segways for Phase II.
5. Increase resource services from half-day to full-time to support the volunteer team.
