



Estate agencies keep neighbourhoods smart

What really makes a neighbourhood a place to call home is the people and the way they gather as communities to look after the place where they spend their days. It's that sense of pride backed by action. That's the aim of the SFB (Sea Point, Fresnaye and Bantry Bay) Crime & Grime initiative.

Now SFB Ratepayers Association in conjunction with corporate sponsors Pam Golding Properties and Dogon Group, and support sponsors Century21, Durr Estates, REMAX, Seeff, Sothebys, and REBOSA, are taking the steps to keep the areas safer and cleaner.

This is what the SFB Crime & Grime initiative take on in Sea Point Phase I:

- Tackle crime, litter and general anti-social behaviour.
- Have security officers patrolling Beach Road and the Promenade and some side Roads 24/7 on four dedicated Segways.
- Clean up the beachfront with the NPO Straatwerk twice a week.
- Employ a fieldworker to engage with and assist the homeless.
- Remove rubbish in the area.
- Supply dog poo bag dispensers.

These are the additional services they plan to add with your support:

1. Two security Segways to supplement those patrolling in Phase I (Beach Road - Three Anchor Bay to Saunders Rocks).
2. Increase the bi-weekly cleansing by Straatwerk from 2 to 5 days a week.
3. Increase fieldworker from part-time to full-time.
4. Install a further two Segways for Phase II (the link roads connecting Beach and Main Roads).
5. Increase our resource services from half-day to full-time to support the volunteer team.
